The Assistant Auditor General is responsible for implementing the strategic and annual audit plan in accordance with; the Audit Act 1990, quality management guideline, as well as the office policies to facilitate the smooth and effective delivery of assurance services to Ministries, Departments, Quangos and other entities.

Duties of this post include:

- Plan, organizes, directs and control the activities relating to the Professional Practices, Professional Development and Quality Control carried out by staff under supervision.
- Skilled at building internal and external stakeholder relationships, in order to represent the office in dealings with auditees, other legislative audit offices,
- Ability to maintain a high level of knowledge of the Bermuda laws, organizations, risks, systems, policies, and procedures for all of government, as well as current trends in the various fields that are relevant to our legislative work.
- Working knowledge of accounting frameworks:- Public Sector Accounting Standards (PSAS) and International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS)
